


Painting on Flower pots and planting flowers in them to take home to your garden.

HONEY MUFFIN RECIPE

Ingredients:

2 cups all- purpose flour

½ cup of sugar

3 teaspoons baking powder

½ teaspoon salt

1 large egg room temperature

1 cup milk

¼ cup melted butter

¼ cup honey

Either line a 12 slot muffin tin with cupcake liners or grease the 12 slots.

Directions:

Preheat oven to 350

Put all ingredients in a mixing bowl,

Stir with whisk until combined.

Pour into a 12 cupcake lined muffin tin evenly, should be perfect amount to fill all 12 cups.

Bake time 15 to 18 minutes. Bake until a toothpick inserted in center comes out clean.

You can serve warm or cooled. These are freezable. Wait till cooled though before freezing.

BIG NOTE: ALL OVENS VARY SO DO KEEP AN EYE ON BAKE TIME. THE BOTTOMS WILL BURN EASILY DUE TO THE HONEY.
